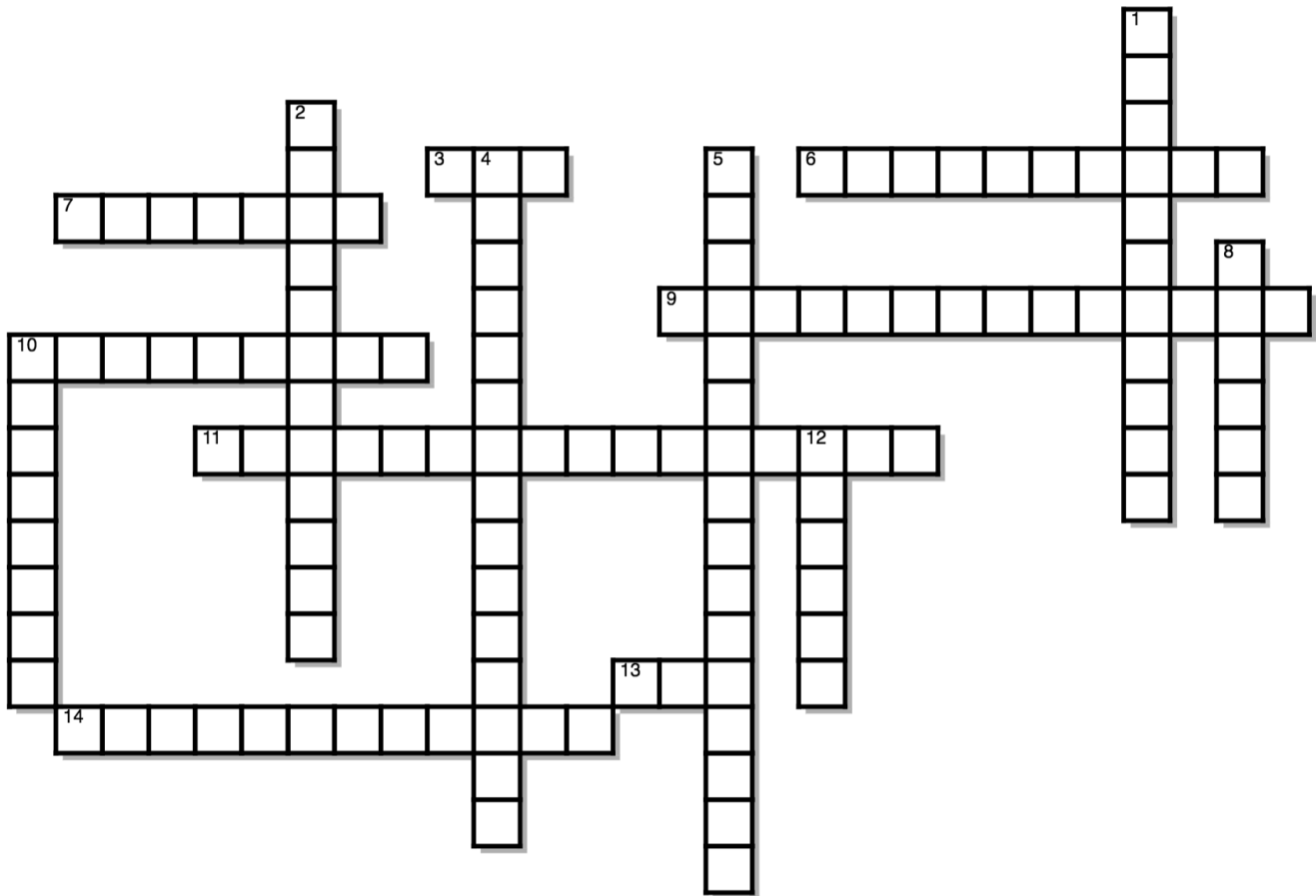




Head & Neck trauma crossword

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ACROSS

3. A clear fluid that may leak from the ear or nose after sustaining a base of skull fracture (3)
6. The hearing loss seen in a tympanic perforation (10)
7. An eponymous name for the sign that is depicted as bilateral mastoid ecchymosis (7)
9. The colloquial term used to describe a pinna haematoma (11, 3)
10. The number of bones in the skull of an adult human (6, 3)
11. The name of the operation that is used to straighten the nasal bones and cartilage (16)
13. The name of the procedure that can be used to treat deviated nasal bones within a two weeks post-injury (3)
14. The name of a relatively rare type of facial fracture that can trap the eye muscles, affecting eye movements (7, 5)

DOWN

1. The initial investigation for a neck laceration that has a non-pulsatile, non-expanding haematoma with paraesthesia around the wound edges (11)
2. A collection of blood behind the eardrum post-trauma (12)
4. A potential complication of nasal trauma that is a swelling in the partition of the nose (6, 9)
5. The geometric named area of the face that is particularly susceptible to life-threatening infections (8,2,6)
8. A periorbital sign seen in craniofacial trauma that shares a name with a North American mammal (7)
10. The bone, that if displaced can cause a facial palsy (8)
12. A physical nasal deformity that can occur secondary to the complication named in 4 down (6)
